

ACCOMMODATION GUIDE-CANADA'S NATIONAL PARKS 1966-67

Selected areas of the outstanding and varied natural scenery of Canada are preserved in 19 national parks across this vast country. From the surf-washed shores of the Atlantic, across the great central plains to the snow-capped peaks of the Rockies, a chain of these parks offers vacation opportunities amid the wonders of nature.

Facilities for the accommodation of park visitors vary widely from campgrounds and trailer areas in carefully selected locations, to luxury resorts, hotels, and other establishments with every upto-date convenience.

Commercial Accommodation

All visitor accommodation in the national parks is inspected by the Natural and Historic Resources Branch, and maximum daily rates are posted in rooms to inform guests of correct charges. Complaints may be made in writing to the park superintendent. Rates quoted here are the latest available at the time of printing (May 28, 1966) and may be subject to change.

American Plan rates (which include meals) are used at only a few resort hotels and are signified by (A) where these rates are applicable. Rates at other places are for accommodation only. Information on other services available to guests is obtainable from the manager or staff of the motel, lodge or hotel listed. TO AVOID DISAPPOINTMENT, IT IS ADVISABLE TO WRITE TO THE ESTABLISHMENTS CONCERNED FOR RESERVATIONS. THE NATURAL AND HISTORIC RESOURCES BRANCH CANNOT ARRANGE RESERVATIONS.

Camping

Campgrounds are of three main types:

SERVICED, for which a nominal fee is charged—usually provide kitchen shelters, stoves or fireplaces, hot water, electricity and toilets. In some, laundry facilities, showers and coin-operated washers are also found.

SEMI-SERVICED, for use free—are less well equipped but have kitchen shelters, stoves or fireplaces, drinking water and toilet facilities.

PRIMITIVE, also free—where there is no direct access by highway; provide only the minimum conveniences.

The use of campgrounds and trailer areas is on a first-come, first-served basis and reservations are not accepted. In most cases, camping in serviced areas is restricted to a limited period of time, generally two weeks.

Visitors wishing to camp elsewhere in approved areas of a park may do so upon obtaining camping and fire permits from the Warden Service.

Dogs are permitted in camping areas but must be kept on a leash at all times for the protection of wildlife.

Group camping sites are available in each national park and organized groups may write to the Superintendent of the national park to make a reservation. These group camping areas can be used only by organized groups directed by a qualified leader.

The normal season for camping in these parks is from late May into October, but this varies according to the climate of the locality.

These fees are subject to change.

All electric services in campgrounds are 60 cycle. Wood fuel is supplied free to all camping and picnicking grounds.

The serviced campgrounds have full-time caretakers and some have matrons in attendance during the mid-summer months. Other campgrounds have part-time supervision.

Picnic Areas

Many picnic areas are provided free at selected locations usually convenient to park roads. Tables, fireplaces and drinking water are available at most of these. Camping is not permitted in picnic areas.

Trailer Restrictions in National Parks

- 1. No person shall drive or operate a combination passenger automobile and house trailer
- (a) that exceeds fifty feet in overall length or eight feet in width on
- (i) the Edmonton-Jasper Highway; or
- (ii) the Banff-Windermere Highway between Mount Eisenhower Junction in Banff park and the western boundary of Kootenay park; or
- (b) that exceeds forty feet in overall length or eight feet in width on the Banff-Jasper Highway in Banff and Jasper parks.
- 2. No person shall operate a bus, truck or combination passenger automobile and house trailer

- (a) that exceeds fifty feet in overall length or eight feet in width on highways in Waterton Lakes, Elk Island, Prince Albert, Riding Mountain, Point Pelee, Fundy and Prince Edward Island parks; or
- (b) that exceeds forty feet in overall length or eight feet in width on the Cabot Trail in Cape Breton Highlands park.
- 3. Sections 1 and 2 do not apply to any portion of the Trans-Canada Highway within a park. The Trans-Canada Highway goes through the national parks of Banff, Yoho, Revelstoke and Glacier.
- 4. No person shall operate on any highway within a park a truck the overall height of which, including its load, exceeds thirteen feet six inches.

Trailers

- 1. No person shall use within a park, a toilet, wash basin, sink or similar appliance constructed to permit the discharge of liquid or solid waste matter directly from the trailer to the ground.
- 2. No person shall deposit liquid or solid waste matter any place in a park other than in such places as may be designated by the Superintendent.
- 3. No person shall park a trailer on any location within a park other than a location approved by the Superintendent.
