



NATIONAL PARKS ARE PLACES WHERE NATURE SHOULD BE STUDIED AND APPRECIATED BUT NEVER DESTROYED


AT THE END OF AN EXCITING DAY THE MARTIN FAMILY RETURNS TO THE MOTEL


