

Ojibway Prairie Complex • Windsor Parks & Recreation

Oakwood Natural Area

This 14 hectare natural area is a seasonally flooded Provincially Significant Wetland. It is an important stopover for migrating birds in spring and fall. In 2016 it was reconnected to Spring Garden Natural Area by a landscaped ecopassage over the Herb Gray Parkway. This connection will improve the biodiversity and overall health of both these natural areas.

Pets **MUST** be leashed at all times. All motorized vehicles are **PROHIBITED**. Please stay on maintained trails.

All plants and animals are protected here. Do not pick mushrooms, wildflowers or disturb any wildlife.
