# MANAGEMENT AREA 28A - TERRA NOVA NATIONAL PARK

NATIONAL PARK Areas excluded to hunting include: a 20 m buffer around the Trans Canada Highway and Route 301, a 50 m buffer around Route 310, a 1000 m buffer around Twin Rivers Golf Course, the community of Charlottetown (including a 1000 m buffer around the playground); a 1000 m buffer around the Park headquarters and the Visitor Information Center at Newman Sound; a 300 m buffer around Cobbler's and Southwest Brook day use areas, Louil Hills Trail, cottage developments along the north boundary (North Broad Cove), Big Brook Pit, and all land to the north of the Eastport road (route 310) to the municipal boundary of Traytown. Areas closed to hunting until October 23rd include: a 300 m buffer around Malady Head campground, Blue Hill Pond and Buckley's Cove trails (Goowiddy Path), Sandy Pond road/trail, the road and trail networks around the Visitor Centre, Southwest Arm day use area and all designated backcountry campsites (see Zone 2, orange shaded area on the map). Important note: there will be areas affected by construction this fall. Please obey posted signs and call or visit our website for up-to-date information on closed areas throughout the season. All that area within Terra Nova National Park on the island of Newfoundland bounded by a line beginning at North Broad Cove (292018m E, 5389506m N); then following a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the salt water at Northeast Arm; then continuing westerly along the shoreline to UTM coordinate 284332m E and 5393589m N at Burnt Point; then continuing in a straight line in a southwesterly direction across the Traytown access roads to UTM coordinate 280850m E and 5392330m N; then continuing in a south-westerly direction across the Trans Canada Highway to UTM coordinate 718389m E and 5384104m N; then following a straight line in a southerly direction across route 301 to UTM coordinate 718651m E and 5376068m N on Gros Bog; then continuing in a westerly direction in a straight line to UTM coordinate 712135m E and 5375846m N; then continuing in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to UTM coordinate 711112m E to 5375089m N;then continuing in a westerly direction in a straight line to UTM coordinate 712135m E and 5375846m N:

then continuing in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to UTM coordinate 711112m E to 5375089m N; then from here continuing south in a straight line to UTM coordinate 710725m E and 5369649m N; then continuing in a straight line in a southwesterly direction to UTM coordinate 708809m E and 5368295m N; then continuing in a straight line in a westerly direction to UTM coordinate 706207m E and 5367663m N; then continuing straight in a southerly direction to the golf course buffer at 706278m E and 5365786m N; then going east to UTM coordinate 708677m E to 5365780mN; then in a straight line in a southerly direction continue to the salt water to the point at UTM coordinate 708688m E and 5363679m N; then continuing along the salt water coastline to North Broad Cove to the point of commencement, including all offshore islands.

An example (E4) is provided in the above grid. Enter E4 in the area of the BIG GAME LICENCE RETURN marked "location animal was shot" if the location is as in the above grid. Further indicate the corner (i.e. NW, NE, SW, SE) of the location block by checking the appropriate box on the BIG GAME LICENCE RETURN marked "Part of block animal shot".


