You are now a recruit for the North West Mounted Police and your challenge is to complete as many activities as you can in this booklet.


Once you have finished Xploring inside the Fort check out the cabin, trading post, trail and picnic area — only a 5 minute walk from the Fort!






### **SWEET BRAND**

### **BUILD IT!**

### GET MOVING &

### MINI FREIGHT WAGON


### Can you complete this mission?

Locate the small Red River Cart and beside it you will find a pile of freight. Load an assortment of freight on the cart—some of it is heavy, some of it is lighter.



Now that you have your freight loaded, can you pull the cart as far as the sign to Eastend, Wood Mountain and back to the start to unload it? Mark in your book how far you got.

- 1. Load freight only
- 2. Deliver freight to Eastend and return to starting point
- 3. Deliver freight to Eastend and Wood Mountain and return to starting point
- 4. Unload freight

### FIND COOK'S TENT

Keep your eyes peeled for a white tent located by two cabins outside the south gate of the fort. This is the cook tent - go check it out! Everything is made without using electricity, just like it was over 125 year ago!






### **SCOUTING ON THE MÉTIS TRAIL!**


Nature is all around Fort Walsh! At the picnic site you will find a trail leading into the trees, go Xplore with your family. The trail takes about 25 minutes to walk.


Like a Métis scout for the NWMP, see if you can scout out and identify some animal tracks.
