




### PITCHER PLANT STOMACH PUMPS



The trails are great places to see animals, big or small. How many different animals can you see on your walk? (Circle) the ones you see.




## MAKE BELIEVE 2




Go to a rocky beach at low tide and start your quest for marine creatures living in the tide pools. How many of these can you find?

Smell the needles. What do they smell like?









#### CHILLAXING ON THE CHAIRS


