

Lots of birds hang out in this park and each of them have their favourite spots. Look around as you explore and draw a line between the bird and the place you see them. Circle your favourite place listed below.

















Build the most amazing sandcastle ever. Check your map for the sandy beach closest to you: Wickaninnish (5), Combers Beach (7) or Long Beach (9).





### TRY IT OUT!

### **SUNDEW SURVIVAL** (summer only)

Your mission on the Bog Trail 4 is to look for the tiny sundew plants that eat insects. To find them, get down low on the boardwalk and search amongst the moss.


What does it feel like when you gently touch it with your pinkie finger? The sticky liquid traps the insect on the leaf like glue, so the plant can slowly absorb the insect whose body provides food that the plant cannot get from the bog.

What uses of the cedar tree can you find in the Kwisitis Visitor Centre (1)?








